- To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Pt. Shiv Shaktilal Sharma Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, AYUSH Gram, Sejawata Bypass, Sailana Road, Banjali, Distt. Ratlam-457001, Madhya Pradesh, (Inst.ID:-AYU0125)** inspection was conducted on **15.04.2025 and 16.04.2025 in hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process **the permission with an intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 18 seats in 03 PG course in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhanta-06 seats, (ii) Kayachikitsa-06 seats, (iii) Panchkarma-06 seats for the academic session 2025-26, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.**
- The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the "Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in the NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024, Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder. **On careful examination of the assessment report following shortcomings/defects have been observed:-**

3. Consent of Affiliation is not submitted for the academic year 2025-26.

4. Monetary penalty of Rupees 3.5 Crore was imposed in the academic year 2023-24. College submitted first and second installment of (Rupees 50 Lakhs each) and the remaining amount of Rupees 2.5 Cr. is pending.

3) The assessment report was placed in the **131st Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on **04.07.2025** On careful examination of the assessment report, considering the deficiencies observed therein as mentioned above as per the **Board policy letter dated 09.01.2025 and 20.01.2025** the college was given an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBISM letter (Hearing notice) of **even no. dated 22.07.2025** to appear on **25.07.2025** before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause as to **why not the permission to your college with an intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 18 seats in 03 PG course in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhanta-06 seats, (ii) Kayachikitsa-06 seats, (iii) Panchkarma-06 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26 be denied.**

4) The college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions **vide letter. No. जावक क्रमांक AY/2025/17295 दिनांक 24.07.2025** against the deficiencies conveyed to them. Whereas, the college through its representatives, **Prof. Dr. Dilip Nalage, Principal of the college and Mr. Neeraj Trivedi, Director Pt. Shiv Shaktilal Sharma Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Ratlam, Madhya Pradesh** appeared before the Hearing Committee on **25.07.2025** and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college. 2) Biometric attendance:- We have installed the AEBAS machine according to the norms of NCISM. We have also got registered on portal and our teachers are also registered on the above portal. We are trying hard to maintain the AEBAS attendance of teachers. But due to some technical reasons related with previously installed AEBAS machine (which we have already mailed in the explanation of Show-cause notice issued on 05-05-2025 by NCISM and also discussed in the Whatsapp group of AEBAS created by NCISM.), some of our teachers were unable to record their biometric attendance. We are also facing internet connectivity issues since some time. Now we have installed another face/iris recognition machine as per latest guidelines of NCISM. We are also providing video footage of last six months of our teaching faculties to prove regular attendance of our teaching faculties.

2) Biometric attendance:- The college authority has submitted that due to technical error in the AEBAS machine and due to issues arising in internet connection, the attendance of faculties was short. Further they informed that college has purchased and installed another face/iris recognition AEBAS machine on 24.07.2025 to resolve the issue.

College has been submitted in their pre hearing submission that they have providing 6 months CCTV footage of faculty attendance but after verification by hearing committee it is observed that the college **has not submitted any proof of CCTV footage in their pre-hearing submission.**

Hearing committee asked college authorities to show the attendance register of faculties and their physical attendance. After verification of attendance it is observed by the hearing committee that 43 faculties were present and 09 faculties were absent on the day of hearing (total 52 faculties on roll). Hearing committee verified all 32 faculties present physically in the college having less attendance during the period 17/04/2025 to 03/07/2025 and it is observed that 08 faculties are on informed leave namely

Hearing committee has asked individually to every faculty for the submission of proof of their attendance in the form of valid proof for their academic/ research/ clinical activities in the form of documents/record/proof/photographs/CCTV footage to prove their attendance during the said period i.e. for 17.04.2027 to 03.07.2025.

In this regard, all faculties submitted that due to technical error in AEBAS machine and due to network issue in the college, their attendance has not marked through AEBAS machine but they were present in the college during the said period. Only faculty namely Dr. Vijeta Kanungo (AYPK00396) has submitted some Geo-tag photographs dated 03.03.2025, 16.05.2025, 19.06.2025, 07.07.20125, 17.07.2025 and 23.07.2025 as the proof for her attendance in the college.

Hence her presence may be considered.

Hearing committee has asked college authorities to submit the CCTV footage of faculties performing biometric attendance/OPD/IPD/classes/practical or any other relevant valid documents/record/proof/photographs/CCTV footage.

Hearing committee has given some random dates as 06th-07thMay, 03rd-04thJune, 28th-30thJune, 02nd-03rdJuly and 15th-16thJuly for the submission of proof of attendance of faculties during marking their through AEBAS machine. In this regard college has shown CCTV footage of faculties only for 06th May, 2025 from 09.15 AM to 10.03 AM while marking their attendance in AEBAS machine wherein most of the faculties identified and verified by the hearing committee.

The committee has asked to submit the remaining CCTV

Keeping the above facts in to consideration, we humbly request you to again reconsider the above facts and kindly grant us the permission for the current session 2025-26 for the sake of college & bright future of the Students studying here.

15-05-2025; the penalty is reduced to Rs. 01 Cr. and requested to consider the same.

Hence the matter regarding monetary penalty is prejudice.

- 5) The observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms regulations, namely, "Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in the NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024, Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020, the recommendation of Hearing Committee was placed in the **144th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) **held on 29.08.2025 and Board concluded that the college is not fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations but is fulfilling the criteria in accordance with the Board's policy letter issued on 09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025. Hence, the Board decided to issue yearly permission with an intake capacity of 100 seats (in UG (BAMS) course and 18 seats in 03 PG course in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhanta-06 seats, (ii) Kayachikitsa-06 seats, (iii) Panchkarma-06 seats for the academic session 2025-26, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.**
- 6) Further, the Monetary penalty of Rupees 3.5 Crore was imposed in the academic year 2023-24. Aggrieved from the above decision you approached before the Hon'ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh at Indore and filed WP no 29602/2023 and as per the decision given by the Hon'ble High Court of Indore vide its order dated 15.05.2025 the penalty was reduced to 01 crore and accordingly you have remitted the amount of 01 crore. Further the Commission has filed SLP bearing dairy 44596 of 2025 against the order passed by the division bench at Madhya Pradesh High Court at Indore by which the Hon'ble High Court has reduced the remaining penalty amount from Rs. 3.5 Crore to Rs. 1 Crore. Hence the remaining penalty amount i.e. Rs. 2.50 Crore the subject to the final outcome of above said SLP pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

"DECISION"

- 7) Therefore, Yearly Permission in accordance with Regulation 54(3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda-2024 and as per the Policy letter dated 09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025 is hereby granted to Pt. Shiv Shakti Lal Sharma Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, AYUSH Gram, Sejawata Bypass, Sailana Road, Banjali, Distt. Ratlam-457001, Madhya Pradesh, (Inst.ID:-AYU0125) in accordance with regulation 54(3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda regulations, 2024 with an intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 18 seats in 03 PG course in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhanta-06 seats, (ii) Kayachikitsa-06 seats, (iii) Panchkarma-06 seats in accordance with Regulation 15 (7) of MESAR PG Ayurveda regulations, 2024 for the academic session 2025-26, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that aforementioned shortcoming shall be fulfilled along with the following requirements:-
- I. It is informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 100 seats and minimum 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 18 seats in 03 PG courses** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
- II. Determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
- 8) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 9) Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical

institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**

- 10) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 11) **Compliance report of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the implementation letters vide ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS dated 09.05.2024 and 06.09.2024 issued by the board.**
- 12) **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
 - iv) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024.
 - v) **The shortcoming/defects mentioned in above Para no. 4, shall be fulfilled.**
- 13) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.
